## Find out more about the new Southgates Health Centre

South Lynn residents are being given the opportunity to find out more about a new health centre planned for their area.

The next South Lynn Neighbourhood Partnership, being held on Wednesday 17 June from 6-7.45pm at the Baptist Church, Saddlebow Road, will focus on giving residents information about the new Southgates Health Centre – which has already received approval for its outline business case from NHS Norfolk. The meeting will allow residents to discuss how they would like to be involved with planning process for the centre; whether it be a formal consultation process or other means such as forming a Patient Participation Group.

The new Southgates Health Centre will offer residents a range of services and will be built in partnership with Morston Assets. Noel McGivern, General Manager at Southgates Medical and Surgical Centre, explained: “The practice team are delighted with the approval of the outlined business case and are working hard to produce a full business case. We are looking forward to providing a full range of services to South Lynn residents including smoking cessation clinics, sexual health and counselling services etc.”

Sue Payne from Improving Neighbourhoods, added: “This is a great opportunity for residents to find out about an exciting new development in their area and have a say in how they think it should look. The centre is still in the planning stages so I hope as many people as possible will come along to find out more.”

It is anticipated that the centre will be completed by the end of next year.
